Joplin Pioneer Cemetery stands quietly at the edge of the Treasure Valley, overlooking the foothills that Idaho's earliest settlers called home. Established in 1882, it is one of the oldest continuously active cemeteries in the state.

"To the memory of the pioneer families who came to this valley in 1880. This sacred place is reserved and perpetuated as they found it. Dry and desolate, many were the hardships and privations endured. Dedicated to the spirit of the old timers and pioneers."

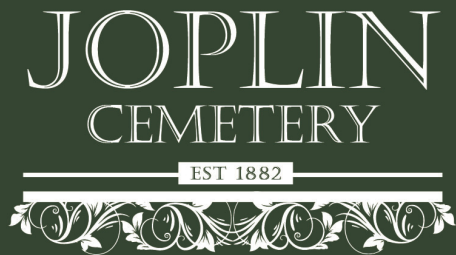

INTERMENT/INURNMENT OPENING AND CLOSING

CASKET BURIAL - Mon. - Sat. \$1700.00

All caskets require a cement vault. (Arranged by funeral home)

CREMATION INURNMENT - Mon. - Sat. \$500

All urns must be placed by cemetery staff.

NICHE (CREMATION URN) PLACEMENT - \$425

LOT FEES - \$700

4' x 10' plots with Headstone Row 48" x 24" and all headstones must fit in this space. Headstones must be placed in a cement foundation, with a minimum of 4" side margins. Permanent markers are required within 18 months of burial. One back of the grave, flat marker is allowed.

NICHE FEES - \$425

Include one, 12" x 12" niche plate. (Engraving and design approved by cemetery.)

JOPLIN CEMETERY APPROVED MONUMENT COMPANIES:

- Boise Valley Monuments
- Memorial Monuments

All burials must be approved & scheduled by Sexton.

We require 10-day notice. All required paperwork & payment must be received before burial is scheduled. You will need Burial permit/Final disposition form, Authorization of interment/inurnment form (Notarized) & Plot Deed.

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All monuments and markers are the responsibility of the owner. Joplin Cemetery shall bear no liability for any damage, deterioration, destruction, theft, or vandalism of grave marker or stone. Should a stone or monument at any time be deemed hazardous, the Sexton shall make every attempt to notify the owner and request restoration or repair (at the owners expense). Temporary markers shall be left on grave for no longer than one year from date of placement.
